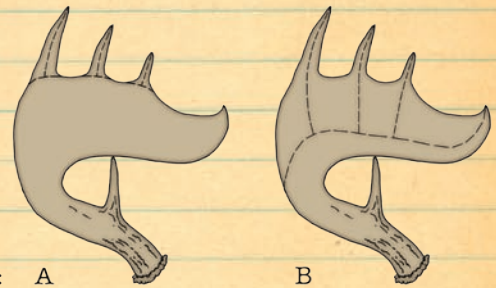
Question 3: Category Boundaries

Question 5: American, Roosevelt's, and Tule Elk

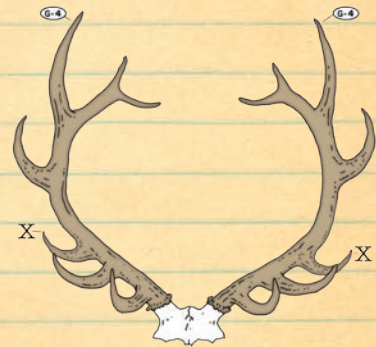
If an extra pair of brow tines (X) should occur below the large dagger points (G-4 Points) on elk, they must always be scored as abnormal points.
