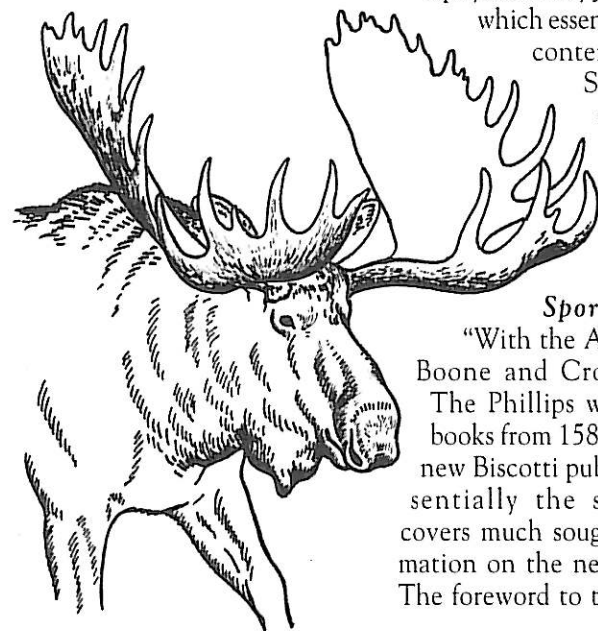


Exciting New Boone and Crockett Club Books are Featured for the Holiday Season

## Spirit of the Wilderness

is the title chosen for the new Boone and Crockett book reviving the Acorn series after a lapse of more than sixty years. The first book of the series was

*American Big Game Hunting* published in 1893 and edited by George Bird Grinnell and Theodore Roosevelt. The series lasted through a seventh book, *Hunting Trails on Three Continents* published in 1933. Grinnell was involved with all seven of the books which included writings by many prominent Boone and Crockett Club members on subjects of hunting, conservation and exploration. The new book, *Spirit of the Wilderness*, eighth in the Acorn series, continues this tradition with original writings by General H. Norman Schwarzkopf, Theodore Roosevelt IV, John M. Kauffmann, Dr. William MacCarty, Richard P. Carlsberg, Prentiss N. Gray and featuring extracts from the previously unpublished sheep hunting journals of Richard Borden, who became a prominent film maker for Walt Disney Company and the National Geographic Society.



## Records of North American Caribou and Moose

This continues the series of record books devoted to specific big game species and which provides state by state and province by province details regarding the origin of the outstanding animals taken. It features hundreds of field and portrait photographs and selected statistics on more than 3,000 caribou and moose trophies accepted into the Boone and Crockett Club's records-keeping system through the end of 1996. Dr. Valerius Geist, Dr. James M. Peek, Col. Craig Boddington, and Thomas A. McIntyre have written information-packed chapters on moose and caribou. The cover artwork of a trophy moose is by renowned wildlife artist, Hayden Lambson.

## A Bibliography of American Sporting Books, 1926-1985

This book, written by M.L. Biscotti and published by the Meadow Run Press, has the unique distinction of bearing the phrase "Approved by the Boone and Crockett Club" on its title page. This work continues the bibliog-

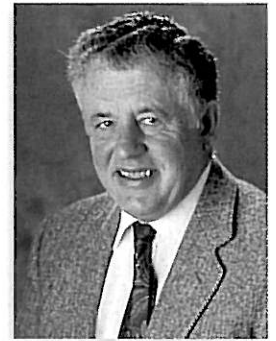
raphy started by John C. Phillips which essentially listed the contents of Charles Sheldon's library and was published in 1930 under the title, *A Bibliography of American Sporting Books*,

"With the Approval of the Boone and Crockett Club." The Phillips work cataloged books from 1582 to 1925. The new Biscotti publication in essentially the same format, covers much sought after information on the next sixty years! The foreword to the book, writ-

ten by prominent outdoor writer, Gene Hill, is probably the last article written by Hill who passed away in May 1997.

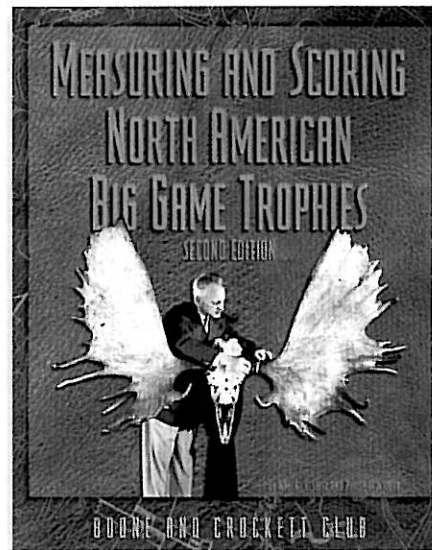
## Measuring and Scoring North American Big Game Trophies, 2nd Edition
