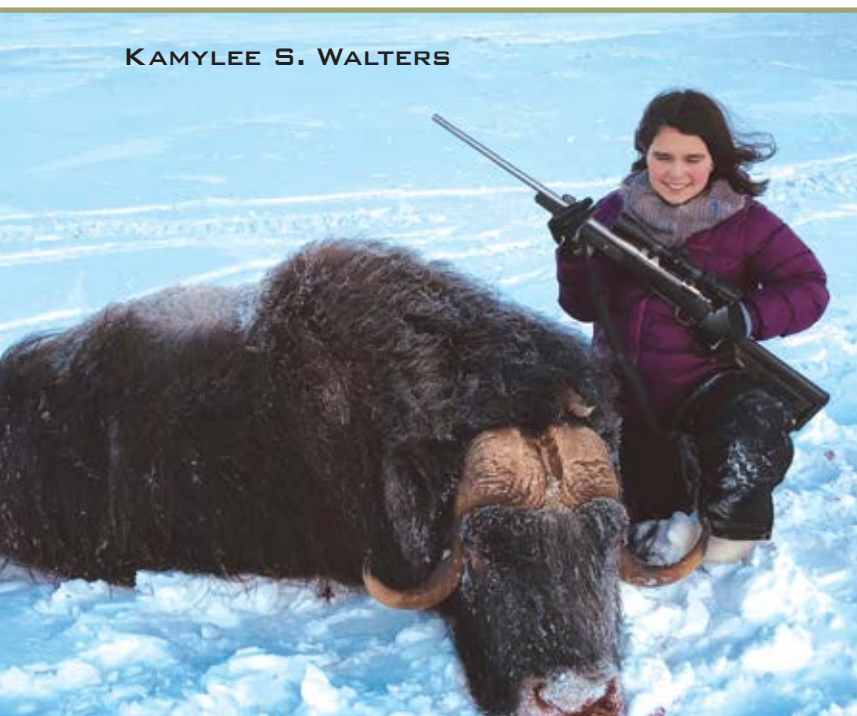

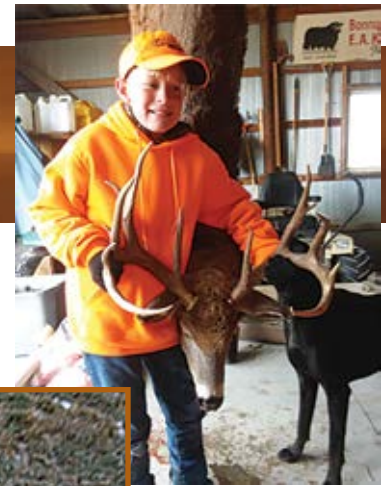

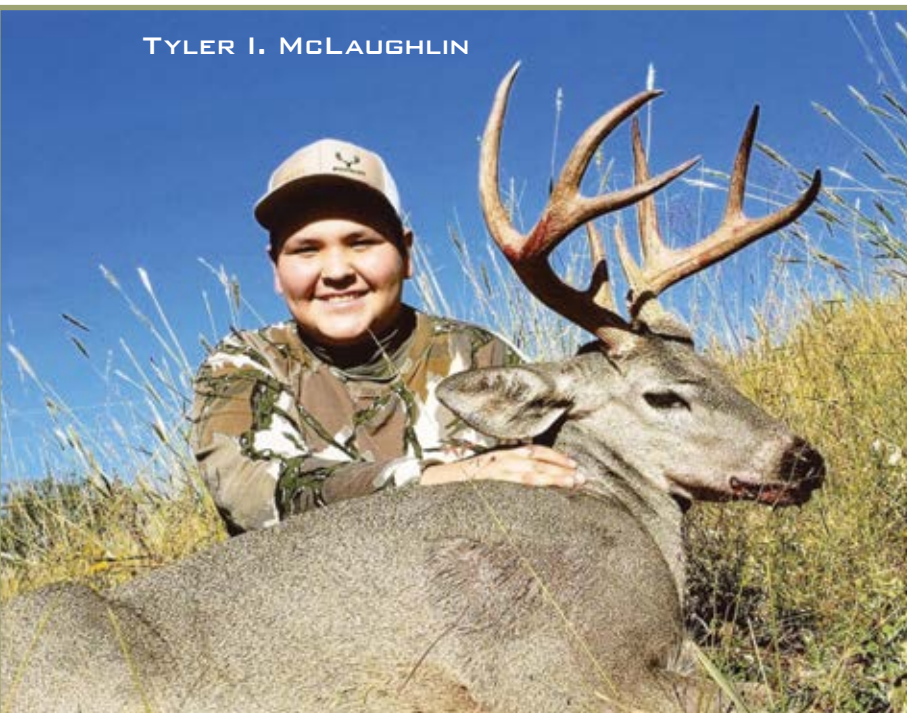
I know I have a big buck and everyone swears I'll never see another one like him, but I ain't a quitter. I'm going to keep hunting till I see one again!
