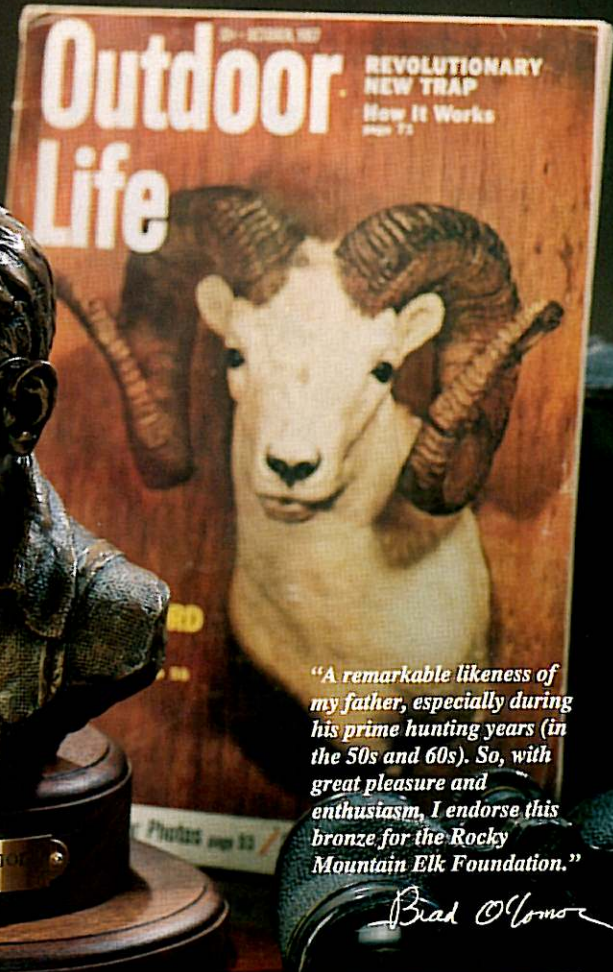

Shooting Editor for Outdoor Life magazine from 1941 through 1972, Jack O'Connor was the world's foremost authority on guns and hunting. His hunting experiences spanned three continents and his insightful and finely executed articles helped shape the way we look at guns and hunting today. Since his death in 1978 his reputation has grown to legendary proportions. In this striking bronze portrait, renowned sculptor Jack Logozzo captures, in remarkable detail, the essence of the O'Connor persona. The sculpture depicts Jack as he appeared at his peak of popularity in the 1960's—wearing his trademark wire-rimmed glasses and the heavy wool shirt and suspenders he wore hunting in the Rockies.

A traditional bronze patina is used to complement the classic nature of the sculpture. Two symbolic .270 Winchester cartridges, cast in bronze, are affixed to the base. This is the cartridge Winchester introduced in 1925 and O'Connor made famous. Each magnificent bronze is sequentially numbered and is accompanied by a certificate of authenticity bearing its serial number and the signatures of the sculptor, Jack Logozzo, and Bradford O'Connor, the son of the famous rifleman.

This exquisitely executed bronze sculpture may become the most desirable and sought after of all O'Connor collectibles. Take this unique opportunity to own a rare work of sporting art.
