**TOP ROW**

This typical mule deer, scoring 186-2/8 points, was taken in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, by Ronald F. Walker in early 2011.

Aaron Gutzwiler was shooting a 7mm Remington Mag. on his 2010 hunt near Cordova, Alaska, that resulted in this Rocky Mountain goat, scoring 47-2/8 points.

Michael R. Smith took this non-typical whitetail deer, scoring 192-7/8 points, in 2010. He was bowhunting in Sussex County, Delaware.

**MIDDLE ROW**

While on a 2011 hunt near Muncho Lake, British Columbia, Tim L. Torpey harvested this 171-4/8 point Stone's sheep. He was shooting a 7mm Remington Mag.

Tom E. Owens was shooting a .30-30 Winchester in Beckham County, Oklahoma, in 2010, when he harvested this typical whitetail deer, scoring 160 points.

This musk ox, scoring 107 points, was taken in 2010 by Stuart I. Hay near Northwest Territories' Great Bear Lake. He was shooting a .375 Ruger Ultra Mag.

**BOTTOM ROW**

Chris Ayres harvested this typical Coues' whitetail, scoring 111-6/8 points, in 2010 while hunting in Sonora, Mexico.

**TOP ROW**

In the fall of 2010, Joshua M. White harvested this 124 point typical Coues' whitetail while hunting in Yavapai County, Arizona.

While hunting in the Cassiar Mountains of British Columbia, during the 2010 season, Jeffery A. Schweighart harvested this Stone's sheep. The ram scores 166-5/8 points.

Chris W. Record was shooting a compound bow on his 2010 hunt in Switzerland County, Indiana, that resulted in this non-typical whitetail deer, scoring 189-7/8 points.

**MIDDLE ROW**

This bighorn sheep, scoring 180-1/8 points, was taken near Las Animas County, Colorado, by Manuel L. Torres in 2009.

Stephen D. Kirk took this typical whitetail deer, scoring 160 points, in 2009 while hunting in Ray County, Missouri.

David E. Liva was hunting in Deer Lodge County, Montana, in 2010 when he harvested this bighorn sheep scoring 189-6/8 points. Liva was shooting a .338 Winchester Mag.

**BOTTOM ROW**

Adam L. Hupf took this non-typical whitetail deer, scoring 209-5/8 points while on a 2010 archery hunt in Dodge County, Wisconsin.

While hunting in Sonora, Mexico, during the 2007 season, John M. Robbins harvested this typical mule deer, scoring 188-4/8 points.
