

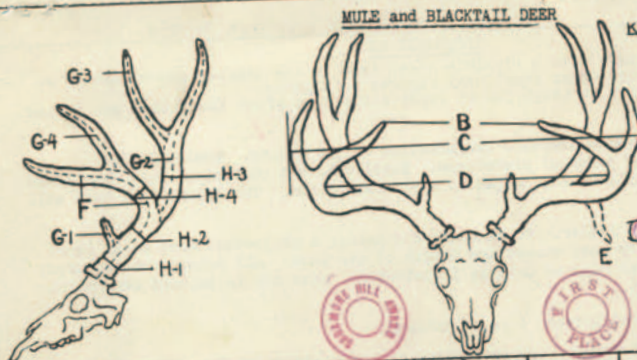

Although this trophy held the title of World's Record for only two years, it remains a stand-out Sagamore Hill Award winner and record typical mule deer. This buck was taken by Edison A. Pillmore near North Park, Colorado in 1949 and scores 203-7/8 points.

As a rule we do not give out this information, and we ask that you keep it strictly confidential until after March 25th. Your mule deer trophy will win First Prize in its class. Also, it has won the Sagamore Hill Medal, a medal given by the Roosevelt family in memory of Theodore Roosevelt, first president and founder of the Boone and Crockett Club, Theodore Roosevelt, Jr., and Kermit Roosevelt. This medal is awarded to the best specimen in the competition, provided the Judges feel any one trophy is sufficiently outstanding to deserve such an award.
 You may also be happy to know that your mule deer trophy (typical) is now the new world's record. Congratulations.
 Again we ask that you not give this information out to the press until after March 25th. If you cannot attend the Awards Dinner, your medals and certificates will be mailed to you.
