

THE BOONE AND CROCKETT CLUB'S RASMUSON WILDLIFE CONSERVATION CENTER AT THE THEODORE ROOSEVELT MEMORIAL RANCH ◀ DUPUYER, MONTANA ▶



The Club purchased the 6,000-acre Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Ranch in 1987 to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the foremost wildlife conservation based organization. A major reason for this decision was the vast array of wildlife present on this magnificent landscape. From grasslands to limestone cliffs, the TRM Ranch has it all.

In 2001 the Rasmuson Wildlife Conservation Center (RWCC) was built to facilitate place-based conservation education programs. Since then, the Club has successfully communicated their message of wise and shared use through their many unique research, demonstration and education programs, totaling over 50,000 individuals from all over the United States and many other countries!

It is through all of these programs that the Boone and Crockett Club strives to increase the awareness and understanding that the future of our world depends on the choices people make. Education is a key factor in what those choices are. An investment in any of these educational programs will surely build a deeper appreciation of the natural world and conservation through the eyes, hearts and minds of each and every participant.



PROGRAMS AT THE RWCC

K-12 CONSERVATION EDUCATION PROGRAMS

- Spring and fall field trip programs for elementary to college level
- Day trips and overnight groups
- Topics include wildlife identification, botany, geology and landforms, geography, soils, water quality monitoring, hunter education, ranching, bear ecology, birding, cultural history, conservation projects and more!

OUTDOOR ADVENTURE CAMPS

- 5-day residential summer camps for youth from all across North America
- Middle school and high school age youth
- Features presentations from real world wildlife professionals
- Other camp topics include fly-tying, fly-fishing, shooting sports (rifle, shotgun and archery), hiking, swimming, packrafting, campfires, sleeping out under the stars, star-gazing, camp crafts, knot tying and anything and everything else a kid at summer camp could think of!

MONTANA HIGH ADVENTURE BASE

- Nationally accredited Boy Scouts of America High Adventure Camp
- The only BSA High Adventure offering ultra-light, wilderness packrafting expeditions in North America
- Maintains a “scout-led” philosophy to promote leadership skills
- Base camp instruction includes planning their own backcountry travel route, backcountry meal preparation, whitewater and river travel safety, bear awareness and expedition leadership

HUNTER EDUCATION COURSES

- State, University and NGO affiliated programs to cater to all ages, abilities and genders
- Feature ample time at the Palmer Shooting Range to develop necessary confidence and familiarity with a variety of calibers and gauges of firearms
- Topics often include butchering, meal preparation, state law and regulations, hunter ethics and landowner stewardship

BOONE AND CROCKETT ARCHERY MOBILE

- National Archery in the Schools approved contents enclosed in a travel trailer capable of hosting 5 –archers at any one time during public school PE classes
- Travels to area schools to teach archery, conservation and hunting as a tool for wildlife management
- Increases retention, reactivation and recruitment of new and former shooting sports and hunting enthusiasts
- Caters to all ages, genders and abilities and has a proven safe track record
